Our Aims:

At Lynnfield Primary School it is our aim to ensure the teaching of a broad history curriculum based on the skills of:

- Investigating and interpreting the past.
- Building an overview of world history.
- Understanding chronology
- Communicating historically.

In order to deepen their skills as historians, pupils will be shown a variety of artefacts and sources and asked about how they help us to interpret the past. They will be taught how to view evidence with a critical eye and to draw their own conclusions about historical events with an increasing level of independence as they move throughout their school career.

Children will learn about a wide range of historical periods and of significant people throughout British history and World history, including a local study of Hartlepool.

The vocabulary children use to discuss history will be built on each year so that by the time they leave Lynnfield Primary School they will have a secure and extensive knowledge to allow them to communicate effectively as historians.
