

At Lynnfield Primary School it is our aim to ensure the teaching of Music is based on the skills of:

- Performing
- Composing
- Transcribing
- Describing different types of music

Within Years 1 and 2, children are expected to perform, compose, transcribe and describe music. Here at Lynnfield we actively take part in weekly hymn practises where we sing a range of songs. Within this, we focus on the performing aspect, using actions to aid our singing to help our memory. Recently, songs by the 'Lion King' and 'Tangled' have helped us perform to a high standard. Within years 5 and 6, we are creating our own songs ensuring that the lyrics are suitable for the melody. We are able to choose from a wide range of musical vocabulary to accurately describe and appraise music including: pitch, dynamics, tempo, timbre, texture, lyrics and melody, sense of occasion, expressive, solo, rounds, and harmonies.

At Lynnfield Primary School, we have the pleasure of the adults from 'Tees Valley Music' to come in weekly to teach children across the school the basis of reading music, learning musical instruments and compose short pieces of music.
