What is Butterflies?

Butterflies is a very small class for up to ten children aged between 4 & 9 years old. It is staffed by:

Mrs Tennant and Miss Izzett —Full time

Activities are planned to be short and address the areas of emotional and social development that the children need further support to develop.

Children who attend Butterflies will do so for four days of the week, Monday through to Thursday and on a Friday will remain in their base class to practice the new skills they have learnt throughout the week in Butterflies.

Children remain a part of their base class and will access P.E., assemblies, break times, lunchtimes and any other special events and activities which their class are involved in.

Butterflies has two daily snack times, to which visitors are often invited. This is a unique time for sharing news, taking turns, listening to each other and reinforcing positive behaviour.

Open sessions

Butterflies will have regular open session to which Parents/Carers are invited to attend, these sessions are important social occasions for you and your child to share together, therefore it is very important that you attend.

How long will my child be in Butterflies?

Your child’s time in Butterflies will depend on the range of social and emotional skills which they need to develop, the time taken can be anything from 4 weeks to 3/4 terms. The team will meet with you regularly to keep you informed of your child’s progress and can be contacted on the main school telephone number.
