Have a listen to this song by The Bazillions called 'More to Be Done'. Perhaps you could learn the lyrics and have a go at singing it yourself!

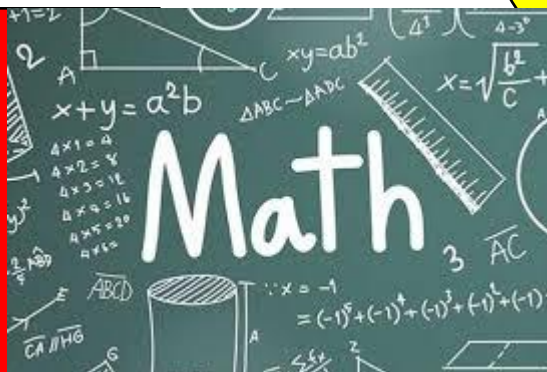
