To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will arrange for them to be tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone
- If my child, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately and arrange for a test to take place, I will inform school of the result and will isolate for 14 days following a positive result
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school with the exception of an outdoor coat and water bottle
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
- I will ensure that my child will follow guidance on good respiratory and hand hygiene
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment – appointments will take place over the phone, I will make appointments via telephone or email
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed to be displaying physically unsafe actions, I will expect school to contact me and I will come in to school to support when requested to do so.
