## Butterflies

### What is Butterflies?

Butterflies is a very small class for up to ten children aged between 4 & 9 years old.

It is staffed by Miss Izzett and Mrs Weldrake – full time.

Activities are planned to be short and address the areas of emotional and social development that the children need further support to develop.

Children who attend Butterflies will do so for 4 full days (Mon – Thurs) a week followed by Friday to practice the new skills they have learnt throughout the week in Butterflies.

Children remain a part of their base class and will access P.E, assemblies, break times, lunchtimes and any other special events and activities their class are involved in.

Butterflies have two daily snack times, this is a unique time for sharing news, taking turns, listening to each other, and reinforcing positive behaviour.

### Parental Contact

Butterflies staff will have regular contact with parents/carers to update them on their child's progress and achievements.

### How long will my child be in Butterflies?

Your child's time in Butterflies will depend on the range of social and emotional skills they need to develop. The time taken can be anywhere from 8 weeks to 4 terms.
